



JURY SELECTION MINUTES

Call for contract of a postdoc Project (ERC-2020-COG – LOFlu - 101001521", designated by "Controlling Influenza A Virus Liquid Organelles")

On the 5th of May 2023, at 11:00, the selection jury formed by Drs Maria João Amorim, Raquel Oliveira and Sílvia Vale Costa, met to analyse the applications to a contract, in the scope of the project (ERC-2020-COG – LOFlu - 101001521), funded by the European Research Council.

The call was open from 09th of March 2023 until 30th of April 2023. The jury analysed the documents submitted in the applications. The call received 5 applications that were classified in the following way (scores on a scale from 0-100):

Comments – Ana Baptista had an impressive CV being an expert in microscopy exactly as requested in the advertisement and that are necessary for the project. Ana Henriques had experience in tissue culture and some experience in microscopy. The list of her publications was impressive, with 15 manuscripts peer-reviewed published. Lex Van Es presented experience in virology but not in microscopy at an advanced level and did not publish his PhD work. Asma Reissaissi did not have experience in microscopy at an advanced level and Lucila Pacífico, has a lot of experience in immunology, but not in microscopy.

After considering all applications, the jury informed three candidates (1, 2 and 3) for interview. However, Ana Baptista has withdrawn her application as she had found another job. Candidates 2 and 3 were interviewed.

The interviews took place in person on 22^{nd} and 24^{th} of May 2023 at 14:00 and were evaluated as following:

Comments – Both Ana Henriques and Lex Van Es explained well their career path and projects they developed. When asked about the LOFlu project specifics, Ana Henriques demonstrated she had knowledge on liquid-liquid phase separation and demonstrated enthusiasm to learn novel approaches and techniques. Lex had limited knowledge about phase separation and was enthusiastic about the project. However, as Lex Van Es did not defend his PhD at the moment of the interview, he could not be eligible for this call and we couldn't consider him further.

Following the interviews, the jury decided by unanimity to recommend the hiring of candidate number 2 (Ana Henriques) based on her ability to use tissue cultured cells to understand which viral and host components undergo liquid-liquid phase separation using state of the art microscopy-based approaches and the demonstrated motivation to develop the project:
