

Gulbenkian Research Scholarships in Portuguese Culture for International Researchers

FAQ

These FAQs do not dispense with the need to read the Call conditions, which set out the rules and procedures.

FOR WHOM IS IT INTENDED?

Who can apply?

Postgraduates of non-Portuguese nationality who are not resident in Portugal can apply for this scholarship.

As a foreign resident in Portugal, can I apply to do research in other countries?

No. This competition is aimed at foreign citizens who are not resident in Portugal.

AREAS OF STUDY AND LEVELS OF EDUCATION

Which fields of study are eligible?

Applications are accepted for research projects relating to Portuguese culture, in the following fields: History, Art History and Literature.

How long does the scholarship last?

Scholarships are awarded to carry out research projects for a minimum of two months and a maximum of 10 months. These scholarships are not renewable.

I'm already carrying out my research in Portugal. Can I apply for this scholarship?

Applicants who are already in Portugal are not eligible.

APPLICATION PROCESS

How can I apply for a scholarship?

All applications are made online, via the FCG website, namely using a special form.

- Fill in the form available online;
- You must upload the mandatory documentation required by the Regulations and then click on the "<u>Submit</u>" button;

The application will only be accepted once the form has been duly completed and the mandatory documentation has been properly uploaded.

Important: to be able to follow your process in the future save your login details (email and password).

How can I register on the FCG website?

How do I access my application?

To access your application, go to www.gulbenkian.pt and log in.

When you enter the "Scholarships and Grants" menu, you will have access to your application area. Click on "Details".

It is recommended that whenever you leave the MyGulbenkian area, you log out.

If you have already started an application, you should also indicate its reference in the subject line of the email as follows: "Gulbenkian Research Scholarships in Portuguese Culture for International Researchers - Proc. xxxxxx".

The Foundation cannot guarantee a timely response to requests for clarification sent in the 2 working days before the deadline for submitting applications.
